

# Tomato Variety List for 2008

Indeterminate: Tomato varieties are vining, bearing fruit prolifically until frost. These varieties require stakes or cages.

Determinate: Tomato varieties take up less space in the garden and ripen a heavy crop over a several week period.

**Abe Lincoln**—(87 Days ) Dark red tomatoes, sweet, solid and meaty. Free from cracks. **Indeterminate**

**Amish Paste**—(74-85 Days) *HEIRLOOM* Produces acorn shaped deep red tomatoes, 8 oz. with thick flesh, and few seeds. Indeterminate

**Arkansas Traveler**—(80-90 Days) *HEIRLOOM* Smooth rose colored tomatoes, mild flavor, juicy, heat and humidity tolerant, crack and disease resistant. Indeterminate

**Beefmaster Hybrid VFNASt**—(80 Days) Popular hybrid beefsteak type, good disease resistance Solid, meaty tomatoes up to 2#. Resists cracking. Indeterminate

**Beefy Boy Hybrid VFFTSt**—(70 Days) Meaty, extra-large main-season beefsteak type with great Taste. Solid 12 oz.-16 oz. deep red tomatoes. Heavy yields. Indeterminate

**Better Boy Hybrid VFNASt**—(75 Days) Great midseason variety, deep red tomatoes up to 1#. Juicy, yet firm tomatoes. Excellent disease resistance. Indeterminate

**Better Bush** VFFNASt—(68 Days) Compact, short internode growth habit. 4" tomatoes weighting 8-11 oz. Excellent choice for large containers or the small garden. Indeterminate Short Internode

**Black Pearl Hybrid**—(65 Days) Fresh off the vine real tasty, but once refrigerated is has a unique, extra sweet 'Concord' grape flavor. High yields. Indeterminate

**Big Beef** VFFNTAST—(73 Days) Old fashioned rich flavor with bred-in hybrid qualities of large tomato size and yield, uniformity and good disease resistance. Indeterminate

**Big Mama**—(80 Days) Enormous, incredibly meaty tomatoes, up to 5"long and 3" across. Great for sauces, practically seedless. Indeterminate

**Black Krim**—(69 Days) *HEIRLOOM* A most unusual novelty. Tomatoes are a dark, deep red (almost a shiny black) with heavy green shoulders. Sweet and tasty. Indeterminate

**Brandywine**—(90-100 Days) *HEIRLOOM* An Amish heirloom that dates back to 1885. Plants look like Potato vines. Good yields, 1.5# lt. rosy pink tomatoes. Indeterminate

**Burpee's Big Boy Hybrid**—(78 Days) Large, crack-free tomato—with absolute superb flavor, Bright, red firm, meaty tomatoes of 1# or more. Indeterminate

**Bush Celebrity Hybrid** VFFNTAST—(67 Days) Abundant 8-9 oz. tomatoes on compact plants. Great Celebrity flavor that balances sugars and acids. Determinate

- Bush Early Girl Hybrid** VFFNT—(54 Days) Compact, patio-sized variety; huge yields of firm, Meaty, flavorful tomatoes. Determinate
- Bush Goliath Hybrid** VFN—(68 Days) Perfect for the patio gardeners or those with limited space. Grows 3.5' tall, producing 3-4" tomatoes that are flavorful, high sugar content. Determinate
- Carolina Gold Hybrid** VFF—(71 Days) Extra –large yellow-gold tomatoes with deep oblate shape KSU recommended variety. Vigorous plants. Determinate
- Caspian Pink**—(80 Days) *HEIRLOOM* A taste that may be better than Brandywine! Thin, light red skin, juicy flavor. Indeterminate
- Celebrity Hybrid** VFFNTASt—(70 Days) All America Selections Award winner. Medium-sized, Globe-shaped tomatoes are crack resistant, averaging 7 oz. Recommended by KSU. Determinate
- Champion Hybrid** VFNT—(62 Days) One of the earliest full-sized tomatoes. Flavorful and prolific, The 6-8 oz. round tomatoes are solid, meaty and very sweet. Indeterminate
- Cherokee Purple**—(80-90 Days) *HEIRLOOM* Reliable producer of unusual, medium pink-purple tomatoes that appear brown in color. Average 8-12 oz. Flavorful. Indeterminate
- Chocolate Cherry**—(70 Days) Extremely flavorful, round 1" tomatoes; resists cracking, dark chocolate red in color. Indeterminate
- Cupid Hybrid** FASt—(66 Days) *GRAPE TOMATO* A very sweet tasting 1" tomato that resists cracking, and holds up well after harvest. Indeterminate
- Early Cascade Hybrid** VASt—(50 Days) Strong cascading plants produce clusters of smooth, red 4 Oz. tomatoes all summer. Fine flavor, easy peeling for canning. Indeterminate
- Early Girl Hybrid** VFF—(57 Days) Meaty, tasty 4-6 oz. tomatoes that have a firm texture, blemish Resistant skin. Heavy yields. Indeterminate
- Early Goliath Hybrid** VFFNTASt—(58 Days) Tomato with superb size, perfect shape, continuous production, luscious flavor and broad disease resistance. Indeterminate
- Fantastic Hybrid** VF—(65 Days) Globe-shaped, scarlet red, 3-5" medium-sized tomatoes are almost crack-free. Rich beefsteak flavor, heavy yields, excellent for canning. Indeterminate
- Fourth of July**—(49 Days) Tasty tomatoes, big enough for slicing. Juicy yet firm. Perfect for summer picnics. Size is 2.5" across. Indeterminate
- Garden Peach**—(75 Days) *HEIRLOOM* Looks very much like a small peach. Small, 2 oz., light-yellow tomatoes have a delicate, distinctive flavor. Good producer. Indeterminate
- German's Johnson**—(80 Days) *HEIRLOOM* Large rough tomatoes, averaging 1-1.5# with pink Skin and yellow shoulders. Very mild, low acid, very meaty, heavy yields, good slicer.

- Giant Belgium**—(80 Days) *HEIRLOOM* Huge, sweet tomatoes average 1-2#. Dark pink, low acid Mild flavor, very solid. Indeterminate
- Goliath Hybrid** VFFNTASt—(65 Days) Smooth bright-red, deep oblate tomatoes averaging 10-15 oz. sweet, luscious flavor, high yields. Indeterminate
- Granny Smith Hybrid** VFAST—(72 Days) Exceptional tart flavor, tomatoes are ripe when still green In color. 6-8 oz. tomatoes makes it usable for grilling or frying. Indeterminate
- Grapette Hybrid** F—(75 Days) *GRAPE TOMATO* Thin-skinned and juicy, with a distinctive flavor and shape. Oblong shape in clusters of 16-40. Ideal smaller gourmet-type tomato. Determinate
- Health Kick Hybrid** VFFASt—(72 Days) The perfect saladette variety—fine-flavored. Juicy, plum-shaped tomatoes. High lycopene content. High yields. Determinate
- Husky Cherry Red Hybrid** VFA—(65 Days) All season-long production of 1" tomatoes with excellent Flavor. Perfect for small spaces or large containers. Determinate
- Jet Star Hybrid** VF—(70 Days) Prolific producer of big, globe-shaped tomatoes. Excellent flavor with low acidity. Recommended by KSU. Very good crack resistance. Indeterminate
- Juliet Hybrid**—(60 Days) All America Selections winner. Larger, grape-like tomatoes that don't crack produces clusters of sweet-flavored tomatoes. Indeterminate
- Lemon Boy Hybrid** VFNASt—(72 Days) Lemon yellow in color. Produces large, deep oblate tomatoes that average 6-7 oz. Mild-flavored, adds inviting color to salads. Indeterminate
- Mr. Stripey**—(80 Days) *HEIRLOOM* This variety has red and yellow stripes covering large, ridge-Shouldered 10-12 oz. tomatoes. Mild, very low acid flavor. Indeterminate
- Mortgage Lifter**—(75-85 Days) *HEIRLOOM* Long-time favorite with good yields of very large, smooth Pink-skinned tomatoes. Very meaty and mild, sweet flavor. Indeterminate
- Mountain Fresh Hybrid** VFFStAs—(79 Days) One of the most sought after varieties. Medium-large 8-11 oz. tomatoes, superior flavor, resists cracking. KSU recommended variety. Determinate
- Mountain Spring Hybrid** VFF—(69 Days) Excellent resistance to cracking! Large, firm 9 oz. tomato. Deep globe shape. KSU recommended variety. Determinate
- New Pearl Hybrid** F—(75 Days) Early and prolific. Extra sweet, tiny tomatoes are produced in clusters. Dark red, round tomatoes, Indeterminate
- Park's Whopper Hybrid** VFFNT—(65 Days) Excellent disease and crack resistance. Nice, smooth 12 oz. or larger tomatoes. Indeterminate
- Park's Razzleberry Hybrid** VFF—(76 Days) Produces clusters of 6-7 tomatoes that are firm and Meaty. Unusual raspberry pink color. Determinate
- Patio Picnic** VF—(65 Days) Great for containers or small space gardening. Grows 2' tall. Produces Bunches of firm, round red 3 oz. tomatoes. Determinate

- Purple Russian**—(80 Days) Plum shaped 3"-4" tomatoes, purplish black in color; sweet meaty taste, crack resistant. Indeterminate
- Red Grape**—(60 Days) *GRAPE TOMATO* Small, oval shaped tomatoes that are firm, meaty, sweet, With few seeds. Produces clusters of 20 or more tomatoes. Indeterminate
- Roma** VFA—(75 Days) Most well-known paste-type tomato, perfect for sauces, pastes and ketchup High yields of red, pear-shaped, meaty tomatoes. Determinate
- Rutgers** VFASt—(75 Days) All-purpose variety, ideal for canning. Attractive, old-time favorite. Full-bodied flavor and disease resistant. Indeterminate
- Sausage**—(75 Days) Unusual shaped tomato 6" long, like huge, red banana peppers. Fine-flavored prolific paste tomato; ideal for sauces. Indeterminate
- Siberian**—(57 Days) Tomatoes average 3-5 oz. and are produced in clusters of 30 or more. Bright Red tomatoes, sturdy plants. Indeterminate
- Sugary Hybrid**—All America Selection Award winner. Super-sweet, juicy, 2 oz. tomatoes. Oval Shaped, reddish pink, slightly pointed tomatoes. Determinate
- Summer Sweet Hybrid** FT—(58 Days) *GRAPE TOMATO* Early ripening, delectable sweet, and weight 1-2 oz. Good heat tolerance and crack resistance. Indeterminate
- Suncherry Hybrid**—(58 Days) Super-sweet taste and earliness in a bright red, utterly delicious, cherry-sized tomato. Bite-size, juicy, and thin-skinned. Indeterminate
- Sungold Hybrid**—(57 Days) Positively luscious, bite-size golden beauty. Thin-skinned, extra sweet, very early, and a heavy producer. Indeterminate
- Sunmaster Hybrid** VFFASt—(72 Days) Perfect for the hot, humid Kansas summers! Produces even when temperatures reach 90-96degree temperatures. KSU recommended. Determinate
- Super Marzano Hybrid** VFNTA—(90 Days) A giant pear-type, high in pectin, giving sauces and Pastes a natural thickness. Tomatoes are 4 oz. 5"long. Indeterminate
- Supersonic Hybrid** VF—(75 Days) Big, red tomatoes with flavor, size and quality. Firm, meaty, and resistant to cracking. High yields. Indeterminate
- Supersteak Hybrid** VFN—(80 Days) One of the top-rated beefsteak hybrids. Extra-large, smooth tomatoes that are meaty and juicy. Indeterminate
- Super Sweet 100 Hybrid** VF—(65 Days) Produces long strands of 100 or more super-sweet cherry tomatoes, weighing about 1 oz. Extra-high in Vitamin C. Indeterminate
- Sweet Baby Girl Hybrid** T—(65 Days) The ultimate in super-sweet cherry tomatoes! Long clusters of 1 oz. tomatoes. Crack resistant, keep well. Indeterminate
- Sweet Olive** VFN—(57 Days) *GRAPE TOMATO* Wonderful choice for home use in salads. Compact growth habit for the small garden. Determinate

**Viva Italia Hybrid** VFFNAsT—(70 Days) Hybrid paste tomato with great disease resistance. Classic, blocky pear shape. Exceptionally high yielder. Determinate

**Window-Box Roma Hybrid** VFSt—(70 Days) High yield of 2 oz. pear-shaped tomatoes. Excellent flavor. Great choice for containers, planters, and patio pots. Determinate

**Yellow Brandywine**—(90-100 Days) *HEIRLOOM* Golden-yellow version of Brandywine, with prolific yields of flattened, semi-irregular tomatoes. Indeterminate

**Yellow Pear**—(78 Days) Vigorous vines produce high yields of 2", yellow-skinned, pear-shaped tomatoes with few seeds. Dependable performance. Indeterminate

## Pepper Variety List for 2008

**Anaheim Chili**—(75 Days) *HOT* Popular two-celled, medium-hot pepper with medium thick flesh. Peppers start out green, maturing to red. High yields on bushy plants. Recommended by KSU

**Ancho**—(76-80 Days) *HOT* Heart shaped peppers are 4" x 2.5" at the shoulder, medium-thick flesh and turns from blackish-green to rust to red as they mature. Rich flavor.

**Aruba**—(65 Days) *HOT* A cubanelle-type pepper, 3-4 lobed and up to 10" long. Distinctive flavor That is mildly sweet and fruity with a hint of heat. Perfect for salads and stir-frys. Matures from lime-green to orange to red to chocolate. High yields.

**Baby Red**—(60 Days) *SWEET* A miniature bell pepper 1.5" x 1.5", has 3 lobes with thick flesh. Matures from green to red with a terrific sweet taste. Very unique!

**Blushing Beauty Hybrid**—(72 Days) *SWEET* All America Selection winner. Pepper go from ivory to orange, and then to bright red. Blocky, thick-walled, 4-lobed peppers. Disease resistant. Recommended by KSU.

**Big Chili Hybrid**—(68 Days) *HOT* Produces huge 8-10" peppers with thick flesh and low pungency. Delicious roasted, broiled and diced. Matures from green to red. Recommended by KSU.

**Big Bertha Hybrid**—(72 Days) *SWEET* All America Selection winner. Very popular for home use. Extra-large, mostly 4-lobed peppers 7" long by 3.5" across. Matures green to red.

**Carmen Hybrid**—(60 Days) *SWEET* Distinctive horn-shaped Italian pepper with delightful sweet flavor. Firm, tapered peppers 6" long by 2.5" across. Matures green to red.

**Early Thickset Hybrid**—(50 Days) *SWEET* The best, early 4-lobed peppers 4"-3" with thick walls and high yields. Produces clusters of 12 or more peppers!

**Fajita Hybrid**—(75 Days) *HOT* One of the best large, 4-lobed peppers with a low pungency and a great taste both raw and cooked. High yields. Milder than Mexibell.

**Fat 'N' Sassy Hybrid**—(61 Days) *SWEET* Unmatched for large pepper size and early maturity. Thick-walled, blocky peppers 4.5" x 4.5". Matures from green to red.

**Foiled You Jalapeno Hybrid**—(65 Days) *SWEET* Perfect for mild sauces, salsa and stir-frys. Not Pungent, not hot, but still flavorful. Thick-walled 1.5" peppers. Matures green to red.

**Garden Salsa Hybrid**—(73 Days) *HOT* A chili pepper designed for salsas. Peppers are 8" x 1" usually picked green in color, Classified as medium-hot. Hotter in dry weather.

**Giant Marconi Hybrid**—(70 Days) *SWEET* All America Selection winner. Large, tapered peppers, 8" x 3" with a sweet, smoky flavor fresh or grilled. High yields. Matures green to red.

**Golden Summer Hybrid**—(70 Days) *SWEET* One of the best golden peppers for production and quality. High yields. Exceptionally thick walls. Matures from lime-green to sunny gold.

**Goliath Griller Hybrid**—(70 Days) *HOT* Versatile flavor—pungent enough to make a fantastic roaster, but mild enough to eat fresh if you like a little bite! Pepper 7"-1.5". Matures to red.

**Gypsy Hybrid**—(60 Days) *SWEET* Extremely early producer of wedge-shaped peppers with sturdy walls, crunchy, firm, sweet flesh. Reliable producer all season. Matures from light green to yellow. All America Selection Award winner. Recommended by KSU.

**Habanero**—(90 Days) *HOT* Extremely pungent!! 1000 times hotter than a jalapeno! Lantern-shaped 1" x 1.5" pods with thin walls, mature from light green to golden orange.

**Holy Mole Hybrid**—(87 Days) *HOT* 2007 All America Selection winner. Mildly hot, with a nutty, tangy bite. Produces glossy, chocolate-brown peppers 7" long by 1.5" wide. High yields.

**Italian Gourmet Hybrid**—(70 Days) *SWEET* Heirloom Italian pepper flavor combined with hybrid vigor! Sweet and spicy 7" peppers that are dark green with very thin skin.

**Jalapeno**—(72 Days) *HOT* Dark green tapered peppers 3" x 1" that mature red. Good fresh or use in salsa.

**Jalapeno Goliath Hybrid**—(65 Days) *HOT* Peppers are 30% hotter than the average jalapeno! Thick-walled peppers about 1.5" across. Matures from green to red. Good texture and flavor.

**Kung Pao Hybrid**—(100 Days) *HOT* Perfect for Oriental dishes. Thin walls dry quickly to seal in the flavor and heat. Produces 4.5" long peppers that mature from green to red.

**Mandarin Hybrid**—(75 Days) *SWEET* Stunning, deep orange color upon maturity. Peppers are 5-6" long with firm, medium-thick walls and distinctive, sweet flavor.

**Marichi Hybrid**—(66 Days) *HOT* All America Selection winner. Pepper are low heat under non-Stressful conditions. Delicate gourmet flavor, fruity overtones. Peppers 4" x 2" long.

**Mexibell Hybrid**—(68 Days) *HOT* All America Selection winner. A bell pepper with a mild chili Flavor. Produces lots of 3-4 lobed peppers with firm flesh. Matures green to red.

**Mucho Nacho Hybrid**—(68 Days) *HOT* Jumbo 4" peppers are fatter, thicker, heavier, a bit hotter, And 1" longer than regular jalapenos. High yields.

**Orange Scotch Bonnet**—(120 Days) *HOT* Hotter than Habanero? You judge! The bonnet-shaped peppers are bright orange when ripe. Flavor is smoky and fiery hot.

**Park's Whopper Hybrid**—(71 Days) *SWEET* Produces huge 4.5" x 4.5" wide peppers. Vigorous Plants with many leaves to prevent sunscald. Matures from green to red.

**Pimento Elite Hybrid**—(72 Days) *SWEET* A heavy producer of sweet, oval to heart-shaped Peppers 3" x 3.5" with thick walls. Matures from green to red.

**Poblano**—(75 Days) *HOT* Slightly hot, with a sweet flavor. Produces peppers 6" x 3" that mature to a chocolate-green color. Thick walled, ideal for fresh use, stuffed, or roasted and used in rellenos or dried as an "ancho".

**Purple Beauty Hybrid**—(70 Days) *SWEET* A novelty pepper that matures from green to dark purple. A nice 4-lobed 3.5" bell pepper. Good for salads.

**Red Beauty Hybrid**—(68 Days) *SWEET* An early, high-yielding 4" x 3.5" thick-walled, 4-lobed variety. Matures from a green-bell quickly to a bright red. Disease resistant.

**Serrano chili**—(85 Days) *HOT* Perfect for chili sauce, salsa, hot pepper vinegar and pickles. Produces peppers 2" long and .5" wide. Matures from green to red.

**Super Cayenne**—(70 Days) *HOT* Long peppers 6" x .5" perfect for pickles, canning or drying. Green peppers turn red when mature.

**Super Chili Hybrid**—(75 Days) *HOT* All America Selection Award winner. Produces 2.5" x 1.5" cone shaped, elongated peppers. High yields of very hot peppers. Matures green to red.

**Super Heavyweight Hybrid**—(77 Days) *SWEET* A jumbo bell that is thick-walled and blocky. Marvelously sweet in flavor and crunchy texture. Mature from green to gold. Perfect for stuffing or eating fresh.

**Sweet Banana Imp. Hybrid**—(65 Days) *SWEET* Tapered, 7" x 2" peppers that are thick-walled And begin light yellow and then turn orange. Perfect for salads and pickling.

**Thai Hot**—(70 Days) *HOT* Very hot! Small, slim dark green peppers about 1" long. Mature to a bright red. High yields.

**Topepo Rosso Hybrid**—(90 Days) *SWEET* Very thick-walled, tomato-shaped bell pepper. Sweet, juicy, up to 1.5" thick walls. Matures green to red.

**Valencia Hybrid**—(72 Days) *SWEET* The first pumpkin-orange pepper, 4.5" x 3.5". Ideal for salads and stuffing. Blocky peppers mature to a vibrant orange.
