Black Pearl Ornamental Pepper–Height 14-18"; Spread 12-16" SUN Attractive black-purple leafed ornamental pepper. Lavender flowers that turn into shiny, round black peppers. Fiery hot taste.

Pentas – Butterfly series–Height 18-24"; Spread 10-18" SUN Long blooming; beautiful star-shaped flowers on umbels 3" across. Attract butterflies, bees and hummingbirds. Very tolerant of heat and humidity.

Profusion Zinnias—Height 10-12"; Spread 12-15" SUN Easy, continuous blooming plants that do well in high heat and humidity. Both double and single flowers available in colors of orange, pink, white & yellow. No need to dead-head; mildew resistant.

Purple Knight Alternanthera—Height 18-36"; Spread 24-36" SUN Dark purple foliage that is an attractive addition to mixed containers or in the garden.. Very tolerant of heat and humidity.

Serena Angelonia—Height 10-12"; Spread 12-14" SUN Plants are well-branched, continuous flowering all summer. Easy, no-deadheading. Beautiful in a mixed container, in flower garden or just a container by themselves. Heat tolerant.

Homer's Top Five Seed Annuals

Basil–This is the smell of summer and it's good to nibble as you walk past. SUN

Height 1-3'; Spread 1-3'

Eucalyptus–Beautiful silver grey leaves with a great scent. SUN Height 2-3'; Spread 2'

Heliotrope–It smells good! Heliotrope doesn't like the heat, so enjoy it in spring. SUN

Height 12-15"; Spread 12-15"

Lavender–It smells good, it's great to touch!

May as well be an annual, if you have clay soil try growing in a pot.

Nasturtium–Nasturtiums usually won't last all summer unless it's cooler. Flowers can be orange, yellow or red. It's another good nibbler plant. SUN
